DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT: The purpose of this project is to install a new triple wide ADA compliant modular home at Anza-Borrego Desert State Park in the Employee Trailer Residence Area. The Modular building is going to be installed utilizing two pre-existing trailer sites and includes constructing a concrete pad approximately 48' x 70' x 6" and installing a 2000 Gallon Septic Tank with three 100' x 20' x 8' deep Leach lines.


REASONS WHY PROJECT IS EXEMPT: No potential for significant impact to the environment is anticipated in compliance with CEQA §15300.2. If the project is implemented as indicated within the project description including comments provided by CDPR specialists, then it is exempt under CEQA §15301 – Existing Facilities, §15303 – New Construction or Conversion of Small Structures and §15304 – Minor Alterations to Land. The action falls under the Departmental List of Exempt activities according to CEQA §15300.4 as:

- "Utility repairs or minor upgrades" (Class 1, Section 15301);
- "Construction or installation of park facilities such as... pads with utility connections" and "Water main, sewage, electrical, gas, and other utility extensions" (Class 3, Section 15303); and
- "Grading on land with a slope of less than 10 percent" and "Minor trenching and backfilling where the surface is restored" (Class 4, Section 15304)

The project does not involve removal of healthy, mature, scenic trees (Class 4).
