DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT:

The Caltrans maintenance station complex has been minimized to a single building and the peripheral buildings on either side have been saved but surplused to Parks. The septic system is still split between the properties; with the leach field and half of the tight-line in front of one of the buildings they gave us and the tank on the Caltrans side. The system needs replacement and this review is for the leach field and half the tight-line only on Parks land. It will be replaced in basically the same footprint and capacity, but with modern materials.


REASONS WHY PROJECT IS EXEMPT:

No potential for significant impacts to the environment is anticipated in compliance with Section 15300.2. If the project is implemented as indicated within the CDPR Project Evaluation Form including measures provided by CDPR specialists, then it is exempt under CEQA §15302 – Replacement or Reconstruction and §15304 – Minor Alterations to Land. The actions fall under the Departmental List of Exempt activities as established according to CEQA §15300.4 as:

- "Replacement or reconstruction of existing utility systems involving negligible or no expansion of capacity" (Class 2, Section 15302); and
- "Minor trenching and backfilling where the surface is restored" (Class 4, Section 15304)
