PROJECT TITLE: Replace Entrance Signs, Mt. San Jacinto SP (14/15-IE-19)

LOCATION: Mt. San Jacinto State Park **COUNTY:** Riverside

DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT:

Replace existing wood entrance signs at Stone Creek, Idyllwild, and Mountain Station with new composite "Branded" California State Park signs. The new sign at Stone Creek will be installed on two posts in the existing footprint of the old sign. The Mountain Station sign will be installed on the existing posts. In order to avoid impacts to the historic district in Idyllwild, a new, branded sign may replace the existing entrance sign on the historic stone posts, provided that it meets standards outlined by DPR historians and in compliance with the Secretary of the Interior's Standards for the Treatment of Historic Properties. DPR-approved standard project requirements have been incorporated into this project. REASONS WHY PROJECT IS EXEMPT:


