PROJECT TITLE: Visitor Center Sewer Connection
LOCATION: Malibu Creek State Park **COUNTY:** Los Angeles
DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT:

This project will involve approximately 182' of trenching with heavy equipment from the sewage discharge of the Malibu Creek Visitor Center to the connection location of the Las Virgenes Municipal sewer line. The trench will be a minimum of 18" in depth and have a fall in grade of no less than 2%. 8" ABS pipe will be laid and fit in the trench with clean outs every 100' then tested for leaks by holding water at 4 psi for 24hrs. All trenching will be appropriately backfilled in lifts if necessary with adequate soil moisture content and compaction. All rehab work will be closely coordinated with resource staff. Septic tank will be backfilled with clean sand or gravel from a local quarry.


