LOCATION: San Clemente State Beach **COUNTY:** Orange

DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT:

The purpose of this project is for the replacement of an existing 24' x 56' modular residence at San Clemente State Beach with a 24' x60' modular. There are no potential impacts expected from this replacement as the new modular shall be within the same footprint as the existing with negligible expansion.

Installation of a 61'x25' concrete slab foundation for placement of new employee residence (Mobile Home) will be required to ensure long term stability of the new modular. Minimal ground disturbance will consist of leveling the existing dirt foundation to accommodate the new slab.
