LOCATION: Lake Perris State Recreation Area **COUNTY:** Riverside

DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT:

Potable water quality at Lake Perris SRA will be enhanced with a chlorination injection system housed within a newly constructed block building at the potable water pump station located at the northwest corner of the park. The existing 30' x 50' chain-link enclosed area will be extended 20' west to accommodate the new facility. This area is an established pump station and is not open for public recreation.
