**DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT:**

This is a special event for two 10k run/walks and half marathons called "Run Chino Hills," to be held in the spring and fall of 2016. The runs will start and end at the Chino Hills SP Discovery center. The routes include Telegraph Canyon Rd., Easy Street trail, South Ridge trail, Diemer trail, and Bovinian Delight. The maximum number of participants for each event is 200. There will be no vendors. Water/aid stations will be positioned throughout the course. Staggered starting grids of no more than 40 competitors at a time will be used to space out competitors.
