DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT:

The purpose of the project is to construct a turn-out shed that will be utilized by the Will Rogers Ranch concessionaire to shelter horses in pasture and store food and equipment. It will also facilitate the interpretation of Rogers' historic use, care, and love of horses. This structure will be compatible with the park unit's historic vernacular ranch style buildings. A combination of contemporary and indigenous utilitarian ranch structures, historical photographs, and similar existing frame structures at the Will Rogers Ranch will influence the design of the turn-out shed.
