


COLLECT, CLEAN AND STORE SEED FROM SITE

- At the appropriate time of the year when it is determined by contractor that grass seed (*Nassella pulchra*, *Elymus glaucus*, *Leymus triticoides*) and tree seeds (*Abutilus menziesii*, *Quercus agrifolia*, *Q. kelloggii*, *Umbellularia californica*) are ripe, it will be the contractor's responsibility to collect the appropriate seed quantities necessary to fulfill contract. Grass seed shall be collected from the project site, tree seed can originate from within the Park.
- Grass seed shall be cleaned and stored at an approved facility in order to maintain viability for later use in seeding work.

PROPAGATE TREE AND GRASS SEEDLINGS

- Once seeds are harvested they will be germinated and grown in containers to sizes stipulated in the plans.
- Seedlings will be maintained in a healthy condition at an approved nursery or other facility prior to installation.
- Cuttings from *Distichlis spicata* shall be harvested and propagated from site collected material.

PREPARE SITE FOR REVEGETATION

- Site will be prepared to accept revegetation as stated in the specifications and includes preparing ground to accept grass seed and removing weeds as necessary.

INSTALL GRASS SEED (BROADCAST)

- Grass seed previously collected from site shall be broadcast over locations identified on plans at specified rates.
- Broadcast seeding shall include a slow release fertilizer at the time of application.
- Seed and fertilizer shall be harrowed in and tamped or rolled
- Apply 1" cover of site collect native grass straw.

INSTALL CONTAINER PLANTS

- 87 tree seedlings and 2400 grass plugs shall be installed.
- Tree and grass seedlings collected from the site shall be planted at designated locations as shown on the plans.
- Weeds shall be physically removed from around planting areas prior to planting.
- Planting basins shall be constructed prior to planting.
- Tree protector tubes shall be installed around new plantings.
- Mulch shall be placed in planting basins.

PLANT ESTABLISHMENT

- Seeded grassland areas and container plants shall be maintained through the life of the contract.
- Establishment activities include but are not limited to:
 - Annual plant replacement (100% survival)
 - Weekly irrigation
 - Weed control in seeded areas and planting basins
 - Replacement or resetting of plant protection tubes
 - Reconstruction of planting basins
 - Mulch replacement
