**DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT:** Issue Right of Entry Permit to OCII for geotechnical investigation activities within Candlestick Point State Recreation Area. Work will include eight (8) cone penetration tests and drilling two (2) mud rotary borings extending up to 50 feet below the ground surface in the Last Port parking area and along the Bay Trail adjacent to Harney Way. These activities are covered under the Candlestick Point-Hunters Point Shipyard Phase II Development Plan Project EIR (State Clearinghouse no. 2007082168).

All work conducted in association with the Right of Entry will comply with all State and Federal environmental laws, including but not limited to the Endangered Species Act, CEQA, and Section 5024 of the Public Resources Code.
