DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT: Install camp host trailer pad with electrical, water, propane and sewer hook-ups near the maintenance building at the Cuyamaca Outdoor School at Cuyamaca Rancho State Park. Trailer pad will be located on an existing cement pad. Trenches will be dug for the following utility connections: 150' electrical from the maintenance building, 62' water from the maintenance building, 170' sewer from the septic line across the access road, propane 20' from the propane tanks. Project supports public safety and education programs.
