DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT:

The project will consist of removing and replacing the three sewage lift stations with new pre-cast concrete sumps, and a duplex grinder, new holding tank, and electrical panels at each lift station. Additionally, a new telemetry system will be installed from the lift stations to the entrance station and new alarm systems and other ancillary support systems for lift station operation.
