**Project Description:**

The Department of Parks and Recreation will protect sensitive resources by implementing targeted bank stabilization measures. The project would stabilize critical, limited sections of the channel bank that are rapidly eroding along four discrete areas of the channel banks totaling approximately 57,120 square feet. The channel banks would be stabilized through treatment consisting of laying back channel bank slopes, installing turf reinforced mats with soil backfill, re-vegetating native tree and grass species, and installing temporary erosion control blankets.

**The California Department of Parks and Recreation has approved this project on, and has made the following determinations:**

- 1.  The project will not have a significant effect on the environment.  
 The project will have a significant effect on the environment.
- 2.  A Negative Declaration was prepared and adopted, pursuant to the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA).
