LOCATION: Plumas Eureka State Park

COUNTY: Plumas

DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT: Upgrade existing facilities at Plumas Eureka State Park to comply with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) and meet requirements in the "California State Parks Accessibility Guidelines". Work will:

Jamison Creek Picnic Area

- Re-stripe the parking lot;
- Remove and replace sections of the concrete walkway;
- Excavate a trench up to 30 feet long approximately 12" wide by 16" deep to extend the water line to a new water station location;
- Excavate an approximately 4" deep by 10 square foot area to install a concrete pad and excavate up to 48" deep by 24" long by 48" wide for the water drain well at the new water station;
- Replace the existing asphalt around barbecues with packed gravel and adjust heights;
- Modify and/or replace restroom fixtures;

Upper Jamison Creek Campground

- Remove portions of the existing seating at the Campfire Center to create additional wheelchair accessible seating;
- Replace drinking fountain with an ADA compliant one;
- Compact the ground throughout the Campfire Center area and the walkway to the parking lot;

Restroom adjacent to Campsite #8

- Replace asphalt walkway and enlarge by approximately 16 square feet to incorporate the existing water station;
- Replace asphalt ADA parking space with concrete,;
- Modify water station height and water faucet connections;
- Install power door opener, modify fixtures, and replace flooring;

Campsites 8, 9, 10, 20 and two additional sites

- Excavate approximately 3' diameter by 9" deep areas to relocate fire rings;
- Excavate approximately 18" square holes for picnic table concrete anchors;
- Install compliant trash receptacles,
- Level approximately 20' by 20' areas for tent pads,
- Replace, resurface, and/or enlarge asphalt parking spaces, spaces will be approximately 23 feet wide where possible.
- Excavate approximately 4" deep by 10 square feet area to install concrete pads around the water stations and adjusting station fixtures and heights.

Overflow parking areas and Madora Lake parking area

- Re-stripe portions of the parking lot;
- Excavate approximately two 1' wide by 2' deep holes to add sign posts;



REASONS WHY PROJECT IS EXEMPT: Project consists of the minor alteration of existing public structures and facilities involving negligible expansion of use beyond current levels included as "modification of existing facilities for handicap access" in the Department of Parks and Recreation's list of exempt activities in accordance with CCR § 15300.4, the construction and location of limited numbers of new small facilities and the minor alteration in the condition of land that does not involve removal of healthy, mature, scenic trees.
