PROJECT TITLE: Restoration of Ceramic Floor Tiles on Various Patios

LOCATION: Adamson House, Malibu Lagoon S.B. **COUNTY:** Los Angeles

DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT:

Several terracotta colored tiles on the exterior structures at the Adamson house including the main house, pool house, and patios have lost their glazed coating and are deteriorating to varying degrees. This project outlines procedures to be followed for all future terracotta tile repairs which would occur on the grounds and exteriors of structures at Adamson House State Park. Tile repairs would take place in steps with a test trial first run on tiles to ensure that no damage is done. The procedures would include: tiles will be cleaned with soft brush; washed with distilled water and a mild pH balanced detergent; after drying tile cavities will be roughed up with sand paper; custom pigmented compound commercially designed for this specific type of repair will be worked into the hole; after drying compound will be sanded to finish level, and coated with reversible water repellent coating. These methods are consistent with the Secretary of the Interiors Standard as well as current methods used by restoration specialists throughout the county.
