**SUBJECT:** NOTICE OF AVAILABILITY AND INTENT TO ADOPT AN INITIAL STUDY/MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION FOR THE PROPOSED JAMISON CREEK-LUNDY DITCH REHABILITATION PROJECT

The California Department of Parks and Recreation (DPR) has directed the preparation of and intends to adopt a Mitigated Negative Declaration (MND) for the proposed project, in compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) and State CEQA Guidelines. DPR is the lead agency for the proposed project under CEQA.

**Project Location:** The project is located within Plumas Eureka State Park in Plumas County.

**Description of the Proposed Project:**

DPR proposes to make the improvements described herein to the Lundy Ditch and failed damsite on Jamison Creek. The following is a summary of the planned improvements:

- 1) **Construct rock step pool reach in Jamison creek at failed dam site**
- 2) **Install pipe in Lundy Ditch to convey diversion water**
- 3) **Attach screened intake to upper step pool to divert water from creek into Lundy Ditch pipe.**

**Public Review Period:**

The Initial Study/Mitigated Negative Declaration is being circulated for public review and comment for a period of 30 days, beginning July 1, 2004. Written comments should be submitted no later than July 30, 2004 to the following address:
