This project consists of designating the space behind Seeley Stables as interpretive. Currently, the area is used for limited interpretive displays including horse drawn vehicles. The project will install and/or include a windmill base and trough, a compost area with 2 compost bins for donkey manure, temporary day pens/corrals, deteriorating freight wagon display, adobe block and clay storage, blacksmith coal storage and public participation areas for equestrian performances, children game area and special event areas.
