DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT:

This is a multi-faceted traffic control project located within Crystal Cove State Park that includes the installation of stop signs, parking signs and the replacement of a previously existing regulatory pipe gate.

Work will not impact and/or extend beyond the park boundary.

REASONS WHY PROJECT IS EXEMPT: No potential for significant impact to the environment is anticipated in compliance with CEQA §15300.2. If the project is implemented as indicated within the project description including conditions provided by CDPR specialists, then it is exempt under CEQA §15301 – Existing Facilities, §15302 - Replacement or Reconstruction, and §15311 - Accessory Structures. The action falls under the Departmental List of Exempt activities according to CEQA §15300.4 as:

- “Trail or road repairs” (Class 1, Section 15301);
- Replacement of existing structures or facilities (pipe gate) where the new structure will be located in the same location as the old structure, with the same purpose and capacity (Class 2, Section 15302); and
- “Installation of signs” (Class 11, Section 15311)
