DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT:

This is the installation of 1 electric vehicle charging device within the fenced lot of the LASHP Maintenance Yard North. It is in response to our Director’s Strategic Initiative 5.2.4, and our past Director’s “Cool Parks” Initiative. The installation will entail digging a 100 ft. long trench, 3 ft. deep, across a dirt roadway from the electrical panel to the maintenance yard.

REASONS WHY PROJECT IS EXEMPT:

If the project is implemented as indicated within the CDPR Project Evaluation Form including measures provided by CDPR staff, then it is exempt under CEQA §15303 – New Construction or Conversion of Small Structures, §15304 – Minor Alterations to Land, and §15311 – Accessory Structures. The actions fall under the Departmental List of Exempt activities as established according to CEQA §15300.4 as:

- “Construction of limited numbers of new, small facilities” (Class 3, Section 15303);
- “Minor trenching and backfilling where the surface is restored” (Class 4(f), Section 15304); and
- “Construction or placement of minor appurtenances accessory to an existing park” (Class 11, Section 15311)
