**DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT:**

U.S. Customs and Border Patrol (CBP) and the Navy Seabees propose to do minor grading (depth not to exceed 12”), filling with local stockpiled material and vegetation trimming of 11,350 feet of dirt roads in Border Field State Park. 350 feet of dirt road will be realigned. Work will be done prior to bird breeding season. This project is intended to protect public health and safety.

The action falls under the Departmental List of Exempt activities according to CEQA §15300.4 as:

- “Trail or road repairs” (Class 1, Section 15301);and
- “Trail construction or realignment”, “Grading on land with a slope of less than 10 percent”, and “Resource management projects” (Class 4, Section 15304)
