**DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT:**

This project is the construction of peeler pole fences to keep visitors on the pathways at the beach and park entrances at San Elijo State Beach Campground. The fencing will protect the plantings and increase privacy in the adjacent campsites.
