DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT:

This project involves pouring asphalt over the existing turn around road/ driveway around Rolling M. There is already an existing turn around road/ driveway there made of crushed gravel base. Pouring asphalt over the existing road base will reduce overall park maintenance costs by reducing the need for regular grading and periodic replacement of road base. This current base will serve as the foundation for the asphalt. All work will be completed by state approved contractors and overseen by DPR staff. DPR-approved standard project requirements have been incorporated into this project. 
