PROJECT TITLE: Huntington State Beach – Lot No. 10 – Gate Placement Project
LOCATION: Huntington State Beach **COUNTY:** Orange

DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT:

The purpose of this project is to install a metal gate at Huntington State Beach directly next to the main service road on the North side of Restroom No. 10. The metal gate shall control entrance and exit to lot No. 10.

In doing so, the following shall be done: Excavate two holes 2-3 feet into the cement on the South side of the service road; install one 6" steel posts to mount the gate to; install one 6" steel bollard to lock the gate to; excavate five holes 2-3 feet into the asphalt on the North side of the service road; install four 6" steel bollards to control traffic and install one 6" steel post to mount the gate to.

Minimal excavation is required to concrete and asphalt. The project aims to excavate as little as possible as to avoid any issues from underground utilities. Dig alert was notified.

Measures to be implemented to avoid significant impact may be obtained by submitting a request to the project Environmental Coordinator listed below.

REASONS WHY PROJECT IS EXEMPT: No potential for significant impacts to the environment is anticipated in compliance with Section 15300.2.
