DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT:

The description of this project; or nature of this project is a special event being The Color Run. This event is expected to bring in about 12,000 participants. Those involved in The Color Run use a colored cornstarch on their person and in the air. All colored cornstarch is cleaned up after the event.

Special Events include all activities beyond the normal scope of park visitor use such as reservation of areas or facilities, conducting business (both for-profit and non-profit) on park property, activity which could impact public access or enjoyment, and requests for exemption from general park rules and regulations.
