**DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT:**

The proposed Project seeks to make necessary repairs The 1949 San Clemente State Beach Entrance Station. This includes repairs for deteriorating wood framed windows; roof eaves and fascia; exterior stucco repairs and exterior paint as well as interior paint, trim and flooring.

Potential impacts are minimal. All repair work will be done according to the Secretary of the Interior Standards and Guidelines for the rehabilitation of a Historic resource. Changes to the building office's overall distinctive materials, features and spatial relationship shall be minimal.
