PROJECT TITLE: EV Charging Station and Auto Pay Machine

LOCATION: Will Rogers State Historic Park **COUNTY:** Los Angeles

DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT:

This project is to install an Electric Vehicle (EV) Charging Station and Auto Payment Machine (APM) at Will Rogers State Historic Park. Location of installation will be in the front parking lot near the park entrance. The EV Station power meter and circuit box is located across the roadway from the entrance station. The power circuit box will be replaced. In lieu of trenching, boring will be used to run power conduit underneath the pavement to parking space locations. Two EV stations will be located against the slope of hillside adjacent to the westerly most parking spaces. Two to three yards of material will be excavated from slope for installation of EV stations. Excavation of 12-18 inches in depth for the cement EV station foundation will be required. Signs and bollards will be placed at each EV site. The pavement will be patched as necessary after EV station installation. The APM will be installed 30 feet behind Entrance Station adjacent to the pull-over parking spaces. APM is a solar unit, so no trenching for utilities is required. Excavation of 18-inches in depth, and 14" square for the cement APM foundation and four bollards will be required.


