DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT:

This project will remove non-historic carpet and replace it with historically appropriate 12x12” square terracotta tiles in a retail space of Fiesta de Reyes (the circa 1930 Pico Motor Hotel) in Old Town San Diego State Historic Park to support continued maintenance and use.
