PROJECT TITLE: Automated Pay Machines (El Pescador, La Piedra, El Matador)
LOCATION: Robert H. Meyer Memorial State Beach **COUNTY:** Los Angeles

DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT:

This project will install three automated pay machines (APMs) in existing pay parking lots. Installation will be as follows:

- El Pescador – Replace existing APM with new solar-powered unit and widen concrete pad as per accessibility guidelines. Remove existing signage and replace with interpretive kiosk.
- La Piedra - Replace existing APM with new solar-powered unit and install concrete pad and walkway as per accessibility guidelines.
- El Matador – Install solar-powered unit along accesible walkway near the restroom area. Parking lot is currently undergoing configuration under a separate project, so exact location of APM will be determined after that project is completed.

All three APMs are solar-powered units; therefore, no trenching will be required for utilities. Each APM unit will require a 3'x3' footprint, excavated to about 18-24 inches in depth for a poured concrete foundation. Bollards will be placed at each corner of the APM that can be approached by traffic. Bollards should be a minimum of 36" above grade, set into concrete with anchoring bars at least 24" in depth, or anchored to a concrete slab.
