DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT:

The purpose of this project is to provide a staging area for the Laguna Beach County Water District (LBCWD) while performing their Anode Replacement and Repair Project.

The anode replacement shall take place along HWY 1 to protect an existing pipeline. LBCWD has a permit with the Department of Transportation (DOT) as well as an easement. For safety purposes, they are requesting to stage equipment on State Parks property, at State Parks discretion.


