**DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT:** Repave approximately 10,000 square feet of paving at the Palomar Outdoor School at Palomar Mountain State Park. Project will also fill cracks in existing asphalt, extend an existing concrete pad at trash pick up location, construct a 4' wide by 90' long drainage ditch, and remove tree roots that are lifting pavement. Project supports continued use and maintenance.
