Dear Trail Enthusiasts:

A public meeting of the California Advisory Board for the Recreational Trails Program (RTP) will be held on Thursday, June 20, 2019 at the State Resources Building, 1416 9<sup>th</sup> Street, Sacramento, CA at 10:00 a.m. in the Sequoia Room located on the 9<sup>th</sup> floor of the building, Rm 950. The agenda for the meeting is on page 2 of this letter. The only action item on the agenda is the election of officers.

As you may know, RTP funds in California are now administered by both the California Department of Parks and Recreation (DPR) and Caltrans through its Active Transportation Program (ATP). As such, following the election, there will be an update on the status of the RTP from DPR and Caltrans staff.

As a reminder, each state that receives funds from the RTP must have an advisory board comprised of both motorized and non-motorized enthusiasts. The board is required to meet at least once per year.
