The Eligibility Card covers the requirements that applicants and grantees must be aware of to be eligible for this federal program. Use it to select a competitive project that will meet the application, grant administration, and post-completion park stewardship requirements.

1	<p>Eligible APPLICANT:</p> <p>Is the APPLICANT a city, county, state agency, or eligible park/special district? Note: Federally-recognized Indian Tribes are eligible for LWCF grants, but are not eligible to receive funds under 10 U.S.C 2684a, therefore REPI program funds could not be used to satisfy the non-federal cost share requirements for projects proposed to occur on tribal land.</p>	Eligible	Ineligible
2	<p>REPI Partner Agreement:</p> <p>1) Is the PROJECT located within an active REPI Program Area? (go to the REPI Map and select "REPI Partnership Opportunity Areas." Areas within the blue circles by military installations are eligible.</p> <p>2) Is there a REPI Partner Agreement in place (or under discussion)?</p> <p>3) Does the APPLICANT have a commitment letter of support from their local military installation to ensure project is compatible with military mission activities?</p> <p>APPLICANTS must coordinate through their existing relationships with their local military installation. 3	<p>Eligible Project Types:</p> <p>Is the APPLICANT applying for an ACQUISITION-only <u>OR</u> combination (ACQUISITION <u>and</u> DEVELOPMENT) PROJECT from a willing seller? (Note: DEVELOPMENT-only is not eligible)</p> <p>And, will the APPLICANT become the landowner through the ACQUISITION to create public outdoor recreation opportunities for the general public, including nearby residents and military families?</p>	Eligible	Ineligible

4	<p>SCORP and REPI Compatible land use: Does the PROJECT meet at least one of the current SCORP Priorities <u>and</u> provides compatible land use within the REPI Program Area?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Local Agency Competitive Program SCORP Priorities • State Agency SCORP Priorities 	Eligible	Ineligible
5	<p>CEQA/NEPA/Section 106: Has the APPLICANT coordinated with their local military installation in regards to CEQA, NEPA and NHPA (Section 106) compliance, and are these requirements underway?</p> <p>Contact the REPI Office at osd.repi@mail.mil; the REPI Office can connect you with the correct point of contact.</p>	Eligible	Ineligible
6	<p>Match: Does the APPLICANT have a match commitment letter from Department of Defense (DOD)/REPI office?</p> <p>Does the APPLICANT understand the MATCH and RATE OF REIMBURSEMENT requirements and have funds to “cash-flow” 100% of the PROJECT costs before reimbursement?</p>	Eligible	Ineligible
7	<p>Timeline: Does the APPLICANT understand the project cannot begin until NPS approval? This includes ensuring no PROJECT - related activities, or other site work from other funding sources, takes place before NPS approval (except for eligible PRE-AWARD PLANNING COSTS).</p> <p>Will the PROJECT be completed no later than 3 years from the NPS approval?</p>	Eligible	Ineligible
8	<p>Perpetuity: Does the applicant agree that the PARK shown on the LWCF BOUNDARY MAP must be protected, operated, and maintained according to the POST-COMPLETION PARK STEWARDSHIP REQUIREMENTS in PERPETUITY, by the Grantee?</p>	Eligible	Ineligible
