PROGRAM GOAL

The Statewide Park Program's (SPP) goal is to create NEW PARKS and NEW RECREATION OPPORTUNITIES in CRITICALLY UNDERSERVED COMMUNITIES across California.

Funding Type

DEVELOPMENT, and ACQUISITION & DEVELOPMENT combined.

Types of Projects

1. Create a NEW PARK
2. EXPAND an EXISTING PARK
3. Renovate an EXISTING PARK

Eligible Applicants

1. Cities, counties, DISTRICTS,
2. Nonprofits with 501(c)(3) status, and
3. JOINT POWERS AUTHORITIES (one member must be either an eligible city, county or DISTRICT)

Application Deadline

December 17, 2026

Amount Available

\$188.5 million approximately

Maximum Grant Request

\$8.5 million

Minimum Grant Request

\$200,000



Eligible RECREATION FEATURE Examples:

Aquatic center, amphitheater, athletic fields and courts, sensory play area, community gardens, dog park, outdoor fitness areas, equestrian and golf courses, rock climbing wall, picnic areas, playgrounds, skate parks, farmers market, public art, etc.
