ORDER # 252-22-002 Date: 11/1/2022

 To ensure the health and safety of persons and property on lands administered by the Department of Parks and Recreation, Off Highway Motor Vehicle Recreation Division; Hungry Valley State Vehicular Recreation Area, the following restrictions are in effect:

All ROV's registered under the California Vehicle Code § 38010(a) and defined under California Vehicle Code § 500 shall be equipped with at least one (1) whip and flag while operating at Hungry Valley SVRA.

- A. A "whip" is defined as any pole, rod, or antenna that is securely mounted on the ROV and extends at least eight (8) feet from the surface of the ground when the vehicle is stopped.
- B. All "whips" shall have an attached flag that is a minimum of six (6) inches by twelve (12) inches and will be attached within the top ten (10) inches of the whip.
- C. Flags may be pennant, triangle, square, or rectangle in shape.
- D. When the vehicle is stopped, the whip shall be capable of standing upright while supporting the weight of the attached flag.
- 2. Exceptions to this order may only be granted in writing by the District Superintendent of Great Basin District at 15101 Lancaster Road, Lancaster California 93536.
- 3. Nothing herein shall affect any existing contracts or property rights
- 4. Nothing herein shall be construed in derogation of other provisions of law.
