Folsom Area State Parks Road and Trail Management Plan

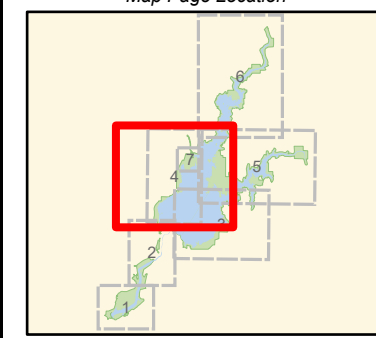
