Old Town San Diego State Historic Park offers visitors a glimpse at the converging cultures that transformed San Diego from a Kumeyaay village to a Mexican Pueblo to an American Settlement. The historic park includes reconstructed sites, along with early twentieth century buildings and five original adobe buildings. Old Town San Diego State Historic Park offers two unique venues within the park: La Casa de Estudillo and Seely Yard.

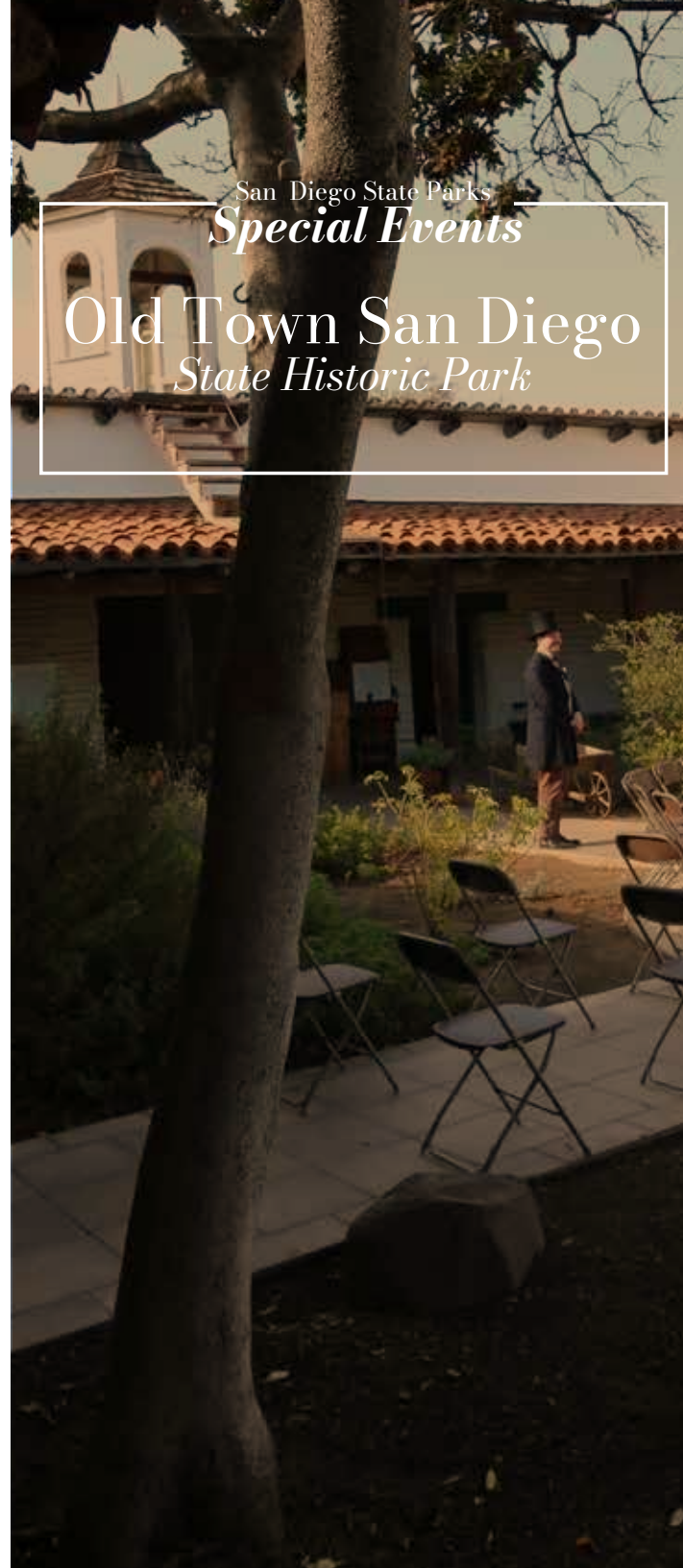
