#### 4\_Interpretation/Education

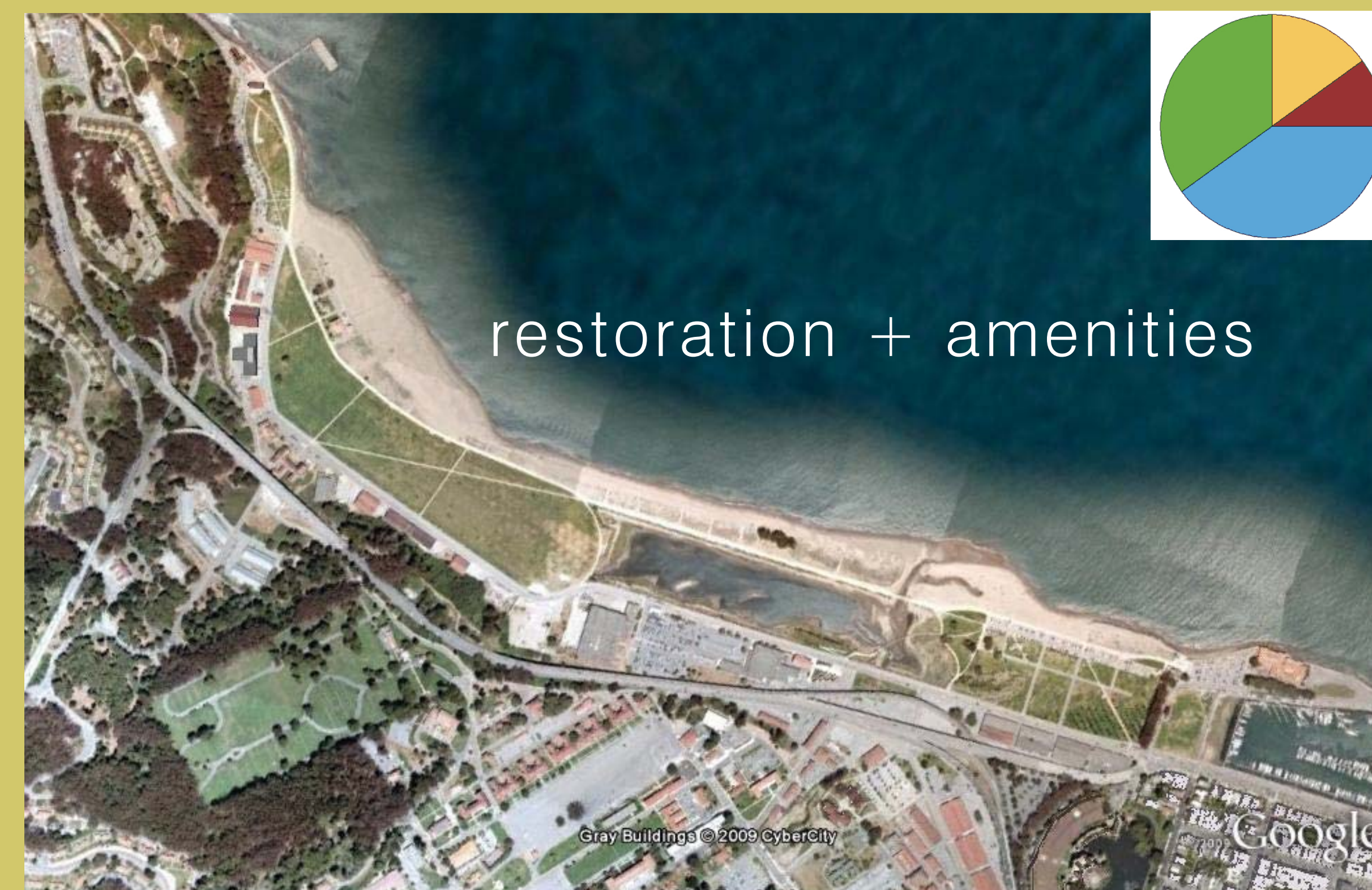
- Demonstrate the transformation of the site over time

- Promote stewardship of the Bay environment



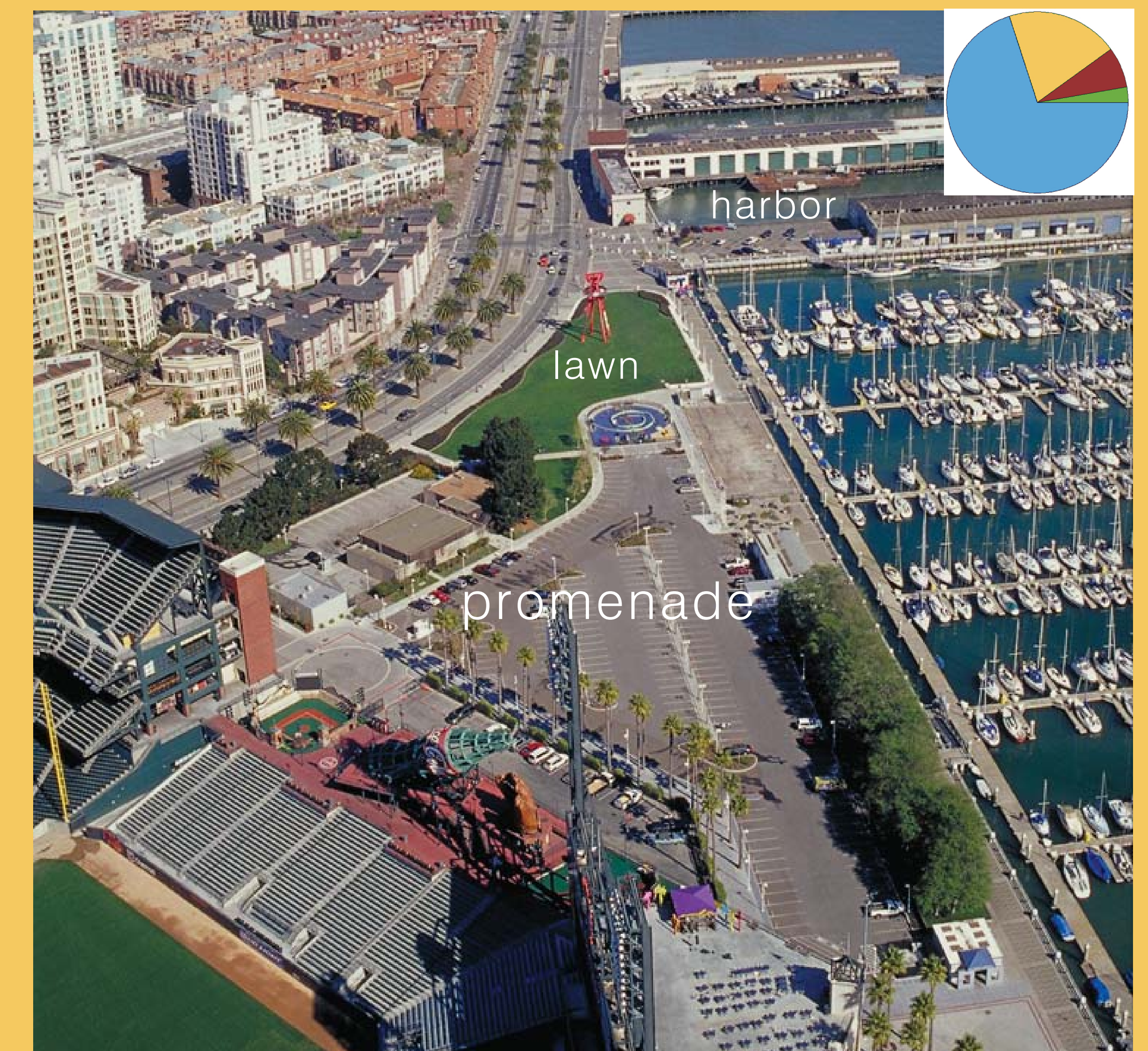
