SB 396

1. **What is SB 396?** This Senate Bill states that beginning in 2018 EEO discrimination and sexual harassment prevention training must be taken by all persons in the supervisor and lead position every two years
2. **Why should I attend DPR training?** Sexual harassment prevention training through the State Parks Human Rights Office specifically designed for people who interact with our employees, volunteers, and visitors. Also its free and we have several training dates and locations throughout the State!
3. **What if I miss the scheduled training?** If you missed training, you can always contact the Human Rights Office at 916-653-8148 and inquire about other dates and locations.
