

Threatened and Endangered Species Addendum

Due to threatened and endangered species which inhabit our forests, beaches, rivers, and coastlines we must solicit detailed information for all events or activities. Please complete the following section which will enable us to meet the requirements of our consultations with the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service and National Marine Fisheries Service (regulatory agencies) on our Special Use/Commercial Use Program. If the proposed event/activity falls outside of the scope of the existing consultations for this program, further consultation with the regulatory agencies may be required. Complex compliance issues may result in an increased workload for our employees necessitating the park to charge higher fees to recover costs associated with this process.
