**SPRC Resolution Recognizing Youth Corps and Their Significant Contributions to

**Resolution:**

**WHEREAS**, Youth Corps provide meaningful work experiences developing an ethic of environmental stewardship and civic responsibility; and

**NOW THEREFORE**, the California State Park and Recreation Commission hereby acknowledges the significant accomplishments of all youth corps and recognizes the important contributions made by youth corps and their members and encourages individuals of all ages to consider opportunities to serve in youth corps.
