Tour Information: The tour is open to the public. The tour is expected to last approximately 5 hours. Lunch is expected to occur at approximately 12:00pm at Moreno Beach in Lake Perris State Recreation Area and tour participants are responsible for bringing their own food, water, and supplies. Lunch will not be provided or available for purchase to the public. A driving tour will continue through Lake Perris State Recreation Area, stopping at various sites, and

concluding at Ya'i Heki' Regional Indian Museum for a short video and presentation from district staff.

The tour participants should consider wearing appropriate clothing and footwear suitable for the walking portions of the tour. Comfortable hiking boots or running shoes, jackets, or layers, and hats are recommended.

Sections of the tour will be on dirt roads. Members of the public will be driving their own vehicles on the tour. Low clearance vehicles may have difficulty on dirt roads.
