TOUR NOTICE

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the State Park and Recreation Commission, pursuant to authority contained in Sections 539, 5002.3, 5019.50, 5080.20 et al. of the Public Resources Code and Section 11120 et seq. of the Government Code, and other applicable law, will conduct a tour on June 25, 2025. The tour is open to the public.

Tour Information: The tour is open to the public. The tour will begin at approximately 9:00 a.m. on Wednesday, June 25, 2025, outside the Rustic Canyon Recreation Center, and includes travel to Will Rogers State Historic Park (SHP), Topanga State Park (SP), and the Adamson House at Malibu Lagoon State Beach. Due to physical closures of the affected areas, members of the public will not be allowed to drive their own vehicles into the affected areas and will need to ride in vans provided by California State Parks.

RSVP is required to adequately accommodate travel logistics. Tour registration will be open June 2, 2025, until June 13, 2025. Groups will need to register every individual independently. [Tour Registration Form \(ca.gov\)](#)

The tour is expected to last approximately 5 hours. Beginning at Will Rogers SHP, district staff will lead a tour highlighting the history of the Will Rogers Ranch, a National Register Historic landscape district, including visits to the adjacent sites of contributing structures such as the main Stables, and the subsequent impacts of the Palisades Fire. From this point, the tour will travel to the Lower Topanga area of Topanga SP, and the site of the historic Topanga Ranch Motel for a presentation of the site's history and fire impacts. The tour will then continue to the National Register-listed Adamson House for a 15-minute tour of the house and its historic grounds. Lunch is expected to occur at approximately 12:30 p.m. before the tour of the Adamson House. Tour participants are responsible for bringing their own food, water, and supplies. Lunch will not be provided or available for purchase to the public. Participants should also consider wearing appropriate clothing and footwear

suitable for the walking portions of the tour. Comfortable hiking boots or running shoes, jackets, or layers, and hats are recommended.
