Clear Lake State Park is on the shores of California's largest freshwater lake. The area is popular for all kinds of water recreation, including swimming, fishing, boating, and waterskiing. The visitor center features displays focusing on the area's natural and cultural history, and an aquarium exhibiting some of the lake's fish species.

Day Trip Option

The park offers various hiking trails throughout; for example, Indian Nature Trail is a moderate, half-mile self-guided trail that shows how the Pomo people utilized the area's resources. The trail passes through the site of what was once a Pomo village.
