RESTRICTION OF PUBLIC ACCESS and HOURS OF OPERATION


Under the authority of California Code of Regulation, Title 14, Section 4326, California State Parks, Northern Buttes District, Lake Oroville SRA will not allow lake access starting one half hour after sunset and ending one half hour before sunrise. Lake Oroville SRA is limiting lake access and public operational hours due to the drought conditions and navigational hazards.

Houseboats and vessels remaining on the water must be on their mooring ball or in a slip during hours of the lake closure.

These restrictions are in effect for the protection of the health and safety of all persons and the protection of property and resources in the area described above.

Exceptions to this order may only be granted in writing by the District Superintendent, Northern Buttes District, 400 Glen Drive, Oroville, California 95966.
