Lake Oroville State Recreation Area Closure

In order to ensure the health, safety, and convenience of the public from the evacuations and damages caused by the Thompson Fire in Oroville, the following regulations shall apply, in accordance with the provisions of Section 4326 of Title 14, California Code of Regulations, portions of Lake Oroville State Recreation Area shall be closed to the public until further notice. This closure includes all of the following:

1. Spillway Launch Ramp and Day Use Area
2. Burma Day Use Area
3. All portions of Brad Freeman Trail and Dan Beebe trailheads to Canyon Drive.
4. North Forebay Day Use Area and Enroute Camping Parking Lot

These areas are within the fire area and anticipated to be closed for an extended period for damage assessment and repairs. North Forebay Day Use will be closed to coordinate responding public safety staff assisting with the fire incident.

Exceptions to this order will be permitted for administrative, Law enforcement, maintenance and emergency purposes to the employees of the Department of Parks and Recreation, their agents and designees; all other exceptions to this order may only be granted in writing by the District Superintendent, Northern Buttes District, 400 Glen Drive, Oroville, California 95966.

Nothing herein contained shall be construed in derogation of other provisions of law.
