### **Exploring the Seasonal Marshlands of the Park ~ Saturday, April 1, Noon - 3pm**

During the wet season a large part of the Park's open space turns to marsh and wetlands. Drop in at our Education Station and see what types of plant and aquatic life exist in the pond areas. Look for the green State Parks all-terrain vehicle with a green flag along the bike path near the Vallejo Home driveway. Suggested: Rain boots or water-proof shoes. Free.
