First Wildflowers Hike Trione-Annadel State Park

SANTA ROSA, CA

Event Date: Sunday, March 5, 2017

Time: 10:00 AM Hike Departure to about 1 PM

Location: Parktrail Drive, Santa Rosa (neighborhood street parking)

Trails: Spring Creek/Rough Go burn area/Canyon

Where would we be without the flowers? Join Volunteer Hike Leader John Lynch on a trail route to identify early wildflowers. The route will include approximately 450 foot elevation gain over about 4 miles of varied trails. This looping route begins and ends at Parktrail Drive and may include sighting of an owl and other wildlife.

Wear hiking shoes, layers appropriate for weather, bring water and snack. Trekking poles recommended. Some trails are rocky and uneven. RAIN CANCELS.

Fee-free hike. No advance reservations needed. There are no restrooms or water the parking areas or along the hike route. Dogs are not allowed.

Directions: from Hoen Avenue eastbound, turn RIGHT on Summerfield Road. Parktrail Drive is the second LEFT. Park along the street respecting neighbors and driveways. Hike Leader will meet you at the top of Parktrail Drive just beyond the STOP sign at the neighborhood trail entrance.
