California State Parks invites friendly people who love to learn to volunteer.

Give to your park through volunteer assignments while you experience your park in your favorite way. Learn new skills by participating in a new volunteer assignment. Enjoy fellowship with other volunteers while serving your park. Volunteers are the glue that hold Annadel together.

Volunteering offers many benefits! Meet new and interesting people, enhance your interpretive skills, contribute to your community, participate in special events, and share our region's rich parkland.

Training sessions are free! Training sessions are held throughout the year at the Trione-Annadel Visitor Center. Training provides orientation as a California State Parks Volunteer. Park and Trail Maintenance volunteers learn on-the-job with tools, crew leaders, and project provided.

Registration and Training:

- Volunteer training is 3 hours and includes registration.
- Equestrian skills test includes an optional trail ride, offered twice a year. Skills test is about 2 hours.
- Mountain bike rider skills test includes an optional ride, offered as needed by other volunteers. Skills test is about 1 hour.
- Hike patrol volunteers learn as you go!
- Visitor Center volunteer orientation is about 30 minutes; shadowing offered. A criminal history background check is required for this volunteer position.
