



Sutter's Fort Trapper's Camp - Frequently Asked Questions

What are the dates and times of the Trapper's Camp in 2017?

Red Bluff Tuesday October 3rd to Friday October 6th, 2017
10:00 a.m. and 12:30 p.m. **(10:00 a.m. only on Friday)**

Colusa Tuesday October 10th to Friday October 13th, 2017
10:00 a.m. and 12:30 p.m. **(10:00 a.m. only on Friday)**

How long is the program? 1.75 hours (some adjustment may be available with prior notice)

When can I make reservations for the Trapper's Camp?

Reservations for the Trapper's Camp are open **NOW** and close on Friday September 29th, 2017. The space goes quickly so you should send a deposit to hold the time you wish as soon as possible. All fees, or staff confirmation, must be received to finalize reservations by Friday, September 29th, 2016.

How do I reserve a space for my class (see note about Home, Private, or small schools)?

1. Download an application for your class by visiting our website at www.parks.ca.gov/suttersfort or www.suttersfort.org.
2. Once there scroll down and on the right hand side you will find a link to the Trappers' Camp Program.
3. Print or download the application.
4. Choose two dates and times that would work in your schedule. We will make every effort to accommodate your first choice. However, times are assigned on a first come, first served basis. **Private and Home Schools, or any schools providing private transportation are encouraged to use afternoon times.** The morning sessions are filled by public schools relying on busses. We try to limit each session to no more than 300 students so we often have to combine schools – especially in the morning sessions. Call or email for greater clarification.
5. Fill out the application and send it, along with your \$25 deposit, or the entire fee, to the address on the application.

What is the cost?

The fee is \$4.00 per person attending. Adults and children are the same price – Teachers and bus drivers are free.

If I cancel will I get my money back?

Cancellations must be made at least four (4) weeks in advance of your scheduled program. If you do not cancel and your group does not show up for its scheduled time your fee will not be refunded.
