Glass Prohibition
Sierra District

No person shall **possess or use any glass bottle, or container, empty or not, within or upon lands of South Yuba River State Park**, under the jurisdiction of the California Department of Parks and Recreation, except that persons may pick up glass containers left or discarded by others and remove or deposit in an approved receptacle. This closure also applies to the **Grover Hot Springs SP pool complex**.

The District Superintendent, or his/her designee, may grant exceptions to this order as determined to be necessary for the proper administration of the park, and to protect the safety and welfare of its visitors, employees and resources. All exceptions, except for emergency personnel, must be obtained in writing. Requests for exemptions may be made by contacting the Sierra District, Superintendent, P.O. Box 266, Tahoma, CA 96142.

Nothing herein shall be construed in derogation of other provisions of law, existing contracts or property rights previously granted.
